<p>Update on the Referendum outcome and the next steps The referendum was held to decide whether or not to adopt the Saxilby with Ingleby Neighbourhood Development Plan. The result was 'Yes' with 91.81% (729 votes) voting in favour of the Plan. 7.93% (63 voted) voted 'No' and there were two spoilt ballot papers. 3317 electors were registered to vote, with 794 ballot papers issued. A turnout of 23.9%.</p> <p>The Plan will officially be handed over to West Lindsey District Council on the 4th May. Two representatives have been invited.
