### **Stirlin Developments**

RP noted Stirlin Developments had been in touch regarding their plans to develop a new site near the Saxilby business parks; the enterprise and riverside parks are expected to be fully occupied by 2018.

A discussion was held regarding the extent the Plan could support the development and whether the site could be identified within the Plan, but it was noted it was too late to do this if the current timelines were to be met. However if there was support for the development, the policies within the Plan could potentially be strengthened.

Stirlin Developments are to be advised to contact the Parish Clerk to RP. request attendance at a Council/public meeting.

#### **Draft Plan**

LBr noted the District Council (WLDC) have identified a gap in the current plan regarding detailed information on the design of new builds. WLDC are looking to cover the cost of a supplementary planning document for Saxilby which focuses on the design of housing e.g. style, material, orientation and type of housing.

LBr explained that Planner Ann Skippers is expected to undertake the review of the draft Plan.

LBr noted Natural England have been in touch regarding the draft Plan and suggested a screening report/sustainability may be required appraisal, in the relation to a European directive. This is due to the draft Plan referring to developing tourism in the Conservation Area. Consequently, this policy may need amending to resolve this issue.

#### **Central Lincolnshire Local Plan**

Consultation on the Local Plan is taking place and a discussion was held regarding the pressure further development may place on infrastructure in the village, with the a local GP practice being unable to fill vacant positions and the school being at capacity.
